Each bidder must submit with his bid a certified or a cashier's check upon some reputable bank of the State of Minnesota, payable to Moorhead Public Service, for at least ten (10) percent of the total amount of such bid, which check and the amount thereof, shall be forfeited to Moorhead Public Service, as liquidated damages if the bidder upon the letting of the contract to him, shall fail to enter into the contract so let. The bidder may submit a bidder's bond written through an insurance agency or cash in the same amount in lieu of a certified check. The successful bidder will be required to furnish contract performance and payment bonds, each in the full amount of the contract.

All bids shall be sealed, shall contain a bid security of the type specified above, and may be filed with the administrator at Moorhead Public Service during normal office hours (8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.) or hand carried to the meeting prior to the scheduled bid opening as specified above. MPS reserves the right to retain the deposits of the 3 lowest Bidders for a period not to exceed 30 days after the date and time set for the Opening of the Bids. No Bids may be withdrawn for a period of 30 days after the date and time set for the Opening of Bids, except with the consent of the MPS.

Moorhead Public Service reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities.
